Trainers also participate in the Community Outreach Program and represent ADH through interviews, tours, outreach events, and educational presentations. In addition, trainers assist with fundraising activities and facilities maintenance as part of their position.


This position may involve travel to Assistance Dogs of Hawaii's campus in Seattle.
